HOW THIS JOURNAL WORKS

One of the greatest spiritual habits that you can develop is spending time daily in the Bible. 2 Timothy 3:16 says that “All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness.” That is the very goal of this journal, to sit in the presence of the Lord daily and allow His word to be our daily bread. Here’s a simple guide, and a sample, on how to journal through the Bible in a year with an acronym called WORD.

W- WORD: Choose one or two verses or a phrase that sticks out to you from the reading. It can be something encouraging or something convicting, or even just something that you find interesting. What’s important is that you write out one thing you can take away from your reading each day.

O- OBSERVATION: This is your opportunity to understand the text within its context. For example, what is the purpose of the verse, who is it written to, and what is happening around the text? Answering these questions helps to provide the necessary understanding of what is happening in order to accurately apply it to our life.

R- RELEVANCE: How does the truth of this text encourage or convict you today. Once you understand the context of what is happening, you can apply God’s Word to your life. Applying God’s Word to our life will result in us changing to become more like Christ.

D- DECLARE: Write out a prayer in response to what you have written thus far. The prayer you write may be one of thanksgiving as you thank God for what you have learned. You may also want to ask Him to remind you throughout the day of what you are learning and should be applying to your life.

O Observation - This passage is about John the Baptist quoting Isaiah about the coming of Christ. This is right before we start to see the work of Jesus on Earth & miracles He performed.

R Relevance - "Prepare the way of the Lord" Prior to Christ's ministry, people were aware and already being faithful in the promises of the Lord. Today, post resurrection, how much more should we honor him in word and deed.

D Declare - Lord, fix my eyes on you. Help me be faithful to you and honor you above all else. Let me be like John - A voice in the wilderness - Calling out for those to know Jesus.
